- Hermaneutics- The branch of knowledge that deals with interpretation, especially of the Bible or literary texts.
- Exegesis- critical explanation or interpretation of a text, especially of scripture.
- Eisegesis- an interpretation, especially of Scripture, that expresses the interpreter's own ideas, bias, or the like, rather than the meaning of the text.

## WHY DO WE READ FOR UNDERSTANDING? -CALLED TO "CORRECTLY HANDLE THE WORD OF TRUTH" -CALLED TO TEACHING, REBUKING, CORRECTING, TRAINING IN RIGHTEOUSNESS, AND EQUIPPING -MEDITATE ON IT DAY AND NIGHT

#### 2 TIMOTHY 2:14-19

14 KEEP REMINDING GOD'S PEOPLE OF THESE THINGS. WARN THEM BEFORE GOD AGAINST QUARRELING ABOUT WORDS; IT IS OF NO VALUE, AND ONLY RUINS THOSE WHO LISTEN.

15 DO YOUR BEST TO PRESENT YOURSELF TO GOD AS ONE APPROVED, A WORKER WHO DOES NOT NEED TO BE ASHAMED AND WHO CORRECTLY HANDLES THE WORD OF TRUTH.

16 AVOID GODLESS CHATTER, BECAUSE THOSE WHO INDULGE IN IT WILL BECOME MORE AND MORE UNGODLY.

17 THEIR TEACHING WILL SPREAD LIKE GANGRENE. AMONG THEM ARE HYMENAEUS AND PHILETUS, 18 WHO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THE TRUTH. THEY SAY THAT THE RESURRECTION HAS ALREADY TAKEN PLACE, AND THEY DESTROY THE FAITH OF SOME. 19 NEVERTHELESS, GOD'S SOLID FOUNDATION STANDS FIRM, SEALED WITH THIS INSCRIPTION: "THE LORD KNOWS THOSE WHO ARE HIS," AND, "EVERYONE WHO CONFESSES THE NAME OF THE LORD MUST TURN AWAY FROM WICKEDNESS."

#### 2 TIMOTHY 3:16-17

16 ALL SCRIPTURE IS GOD-BREATHED AND IS USEFUL FOR TEACHING, REBUKING, CORRECTING AND TRAINING IN RIGHTEOUSNESS, 17 SO THAT THE SERVANT OF GOD[A] MAY BE THOROUGHLY EQUIPPED FOR EVERY GOOD WORK.

#### PSALM 1

1 BLESSED IS THE ONE WHO DOES NOT WALK IN STEP WITH THE WICKED OR STAND IN THE WAY THAT SINNERS TAKE OR SIT IN THE COMPANY OF MOCKERS, 2 BUT WHOSE DELIGHT IS IN THE LAW OF THE LORD, AND WHO MEDITATES ON HIS LAW DAY AND NIGHT. 3 THAT PERSON IS LIKE A TREE PLANTED BY STREAMS OF WATER, WHICH YIELDS ITS FRUIT IN SEASON AND WHOSE LEAF DOES NOT WITHER— WHATEVER THEY DO PROSPERS. 4 NOT SO THE WICKED! THEY ARE LIKE CHAFF THAT THE WIND BLOWS AWAY. 5 THEREFORE THE WICKED WILL NOT STAND IN THE JUDGMENT, NOR SINNERS IN THE ASSEMBLY OF THE RIGHTEOUS. 6 FOR THE LORD WATCHES OVER THE WAY OF THE RIGHTEOUS, BUT THE WAY OF THE WICKED LEADS TO DESTRUCTION.
